

Important dates when introducing final reviews of doctoral theses

Final reviews should be conducted after the examining committee and the opponent have been decided.

The final review must be completed at least six weeks before the public defence. The final review is expected to take two weeks the manuscript should be sent for final review eight weeks before the public defence.
